1st Program in June

Travel Arrangements

- Round-Trip Airfare: Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangement according to the specified schedule.
- Room and Board: World Taekwondo will cover accommodation and meals at designated facilities during the program.





- Participants must arrive at Incheon
 International Airport by 15:00 to use the
 official transportation, which is provided at
 17:00.
- Any arrival after 15:00pm may result in delays or the need to make alternative transportation arrangements.
- The journey to Taekwondowon takes approximately 3 hours, so participants should plan their schedule accordingly.



Departure from Incheon International Airport

- Participants should book flights after 15:00 to use the official transportation, which departs Taekwondowon at 12:00.
- Participants should plan flights with 2–3 hours for check-in.

Traveler's Insurance

Dobok & Belt

Participants will receive one Dobok from World Taekwondo. However, you must bring your **own belt (according to rank) and an extra Dobok** for training and competition.

Certificate

A "Participation Certificate" will be awarded at the end of the program as recognition of your dedication and training.
